#### More on Partnering with God

**Foundation:** Partnering with God is the process of being washed by the Word of God. The Bible says do it and you do it; the Bible says don't do it and you stop. Eph 5: 25, .... Christ also loved the church, and gave himself for it; v26 That he might sanctify and cleanse it with the washing of water by the word,

### A. Hear and Do.

- 1. Gen 2:15 And the LORD God took the man, and put him into the garden of Eden to dress it and to keep it.
  - Gen 2:16 And the LORD God commanded the man, saying, Of every tree of the garden thou mayest freely eat:
  - Gen 2:17 But of the tree of the knowledge of good and evil, thou shalt not eat of it: for in the day that thou eatest thereof thou shalt surely die.
- 2. Deu 28:1 And it shall come to pass, if thou shalt <u>hearken diligently</u> unto the voice of the LORD thy God, to observe [and] <u>to do</u> all his commandments which I command thee this day, that the LORD thy God will set thee on high above all nations of the earth:
  - Deu 28:2 And all these blessings shall come on thee, and overtake thee, if thou shalt hearken unto the voice of the LORD thy God.
- 3. Joh 8:31 Then said Jesus to those Jews which believed on him, If ye continue in my word, [then] are ye my disciples indeed; Joh 8:32 And ye shall know the truth, and the truth shall make you free.
- 4. Rev 1:3 Blessed [is] he that readeth, and they that <u>hear</u> the words of this prophecy, and <u>keep</u> those things which are written therein:

# **B. Strong Blessings of the Meat of the Word.**

- 1. Protection and Provision.
  - Luk 10:19 Behold, I give unto you power to tread on serpents and scorpions, and over all the power of the enemy: and nothing shall by any means hurt you.
  - 2Co 8:9 For ye know the grace of our Lord Jesus Christ, that, though he was rich, yet for your sakes he became poor, that ye through his poverty might be rich.
- 2. All that We Dare Ask.
  - Eph 3:20 AMPC Now to Him Who, by (in consequence of) the [action of His] power that is at work within us, is able to [carry out His purpose and] do superabundantly, far over and above all that we [dare] ask or think [infinitely beyond our highest prayers, desires, thoughts, hopes, or dreams]
- 3. Joint Heirs of God.
  - Rom 8:16 The Spirit itself beareth witness with our spirit, that we are the children of God:

Rom 8:17 And if children, then heirs; heirs of God, and joint-heirs with Christ;

### 4. Ministry.

Joh 14:12 Verily, Verily, I say unto you, He that believeth on me, the works that I do shall he do also; and <u>greater [works]</u> than these shall he do; because I go unto my Father.

## C. Conditions for Receiving Strong Blessings.

1. Confess Your Sins.

1Jo 1:9 If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just to forgive us [our] sins, and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.

2. Walk in Love.

Mat 22:37 Jesus said unto him, <u>Thou shalt love the Lord thy God with all thy heart</u>, and with all thy soul, and with all thy mind.

Mat 22:38 This is the first and great commandment.

Mat 22:39 And the second [is] like unto it, Thou shalt love thy neighbour as thyself.

3. Forgive All Others.

Mar 11:22 And Jesus answering saith unto them, Have faith in God.

Mar 11:23 For verily I say unto you, That whosoever shall say unto this mountain, Be thou removed, and be thou cast into the sea; and shall not doubt in his heart, but shall believe that those things which he saith shall come to pass; he shall have whatsoever he saith.

Mar 11:24 Therefore I say unto you, What things soever ye desire, when ye pray, believe that ye receive [them], and ye shall have [them].

Mar 11:25 And when ye stand praying, <u>forgive</u>, if ye have ought against any: that your Father also which is in heaven may forgive you your trespasses.

Mar 11:26 But <u>if ye do not forgive</u>, neither will your Father which is in heaven forgive your trespasses.

4. Law of Genesis.

Gen 1:12 And the earth brought forth grass, [and] herb yielding seed <u>after his kind</u>, and the tree yielding fruit, whose seed [was] in itself, <u>after his kind</u>: and God saw that [it was] good.

Deu 19:21 And thine eye shall not pity; [but] life [shall go] for life, eye for eye, tooth for tooth, hand for hand, foot for foot.

Luk 6:38 Give, and it shall be given unto you; good measure, pressed down, and shaken together, and running over, shall men give into your bosom. For with the same measure that ye mete withal it shall be measured to you again.

Gal 6:7 Be not deceived; God is not mocked: for whatsoever a man soweth, that shall he also reap.
