Benefits of Our Redemption

Review.

<u>Living with Jesus as Savior</u> means that you have accepted Jesus Christ as the Lamb of God Who took your sins, shed His Blood and died for you on the cross so that you could be born again into the family of God. It means that you can now partake of those benefits in your Salvation Package which Jesus purchased for you by His sacrifice up to and including His death on the cross.

<u>Living with Jesus as your Redeemer</u> means that you have accepted Jesus as **your risen Lord**, King of kings of whom you are one of the kings, made so by the Resurrection Power of Christ Jesus. It means that you are now partaking of those benefits in your Salvation Package which have been provided in Christ Jesus through the power of His Resurrection.

Overview.

Joh 3:16 For God so loved the world, that he gave his only begotten Son, that whosoever believeth in him should not perish, but have <u>everlasting life</u>. Heb 9:15 And for this cause he is the **mediator of the new testament,** that by means of death, for the redemption of the transgressions [that were] under the first testament, they which are called might receive the promise of eternal inheritance.

1Th 5:9 For God hath not appointed us to wrath, but to obtain <u>salvation by our Lord Jesus Christ</u>,

2Ti 2:10 Therefore I endure all things for the <u>elect's sakes</u> (i.e., born again believers), that they may **also** obtain the <u>salvation which is in Christ Jesus</u> with eternal <u>glory</u>.

Rom 3:24 Being justified freely by his grace through the redemption that is in Christ Jesus:

Luk 21:28 And when these things begin to come to pass, then look up, and lift up your heads; for <u>your redemption draweth nigh</u>.

Rom 8:23 And not only [they], but ourselves also, which have the firstfruits of the Spirit, even we ourselves groan within ourselves, waiting for the adoption, [to wit], the redemption of our body.

Eph 4:30 And grieve not the holy Spirit of God, whereby <u>ye are sealed unto the day of redemption.</u>

Rev 21:7 He that <u>overcometh</u> shall inherit all things; and I will be his God, and he shall be my son.

A. Redemption under the New Covenant.

1. Joint Heir with Christ.

Rom 8:13 For if ye live after the flesh, ye shall die: but if ye through the Spirit do mortify the deeds of the body, ye shall live.

Rom 8:14 For as many as are led by the Spirit of God, they are the sons of God.

Rom 8:15 For ye have not received the spirit of bondage again to fear; but ye have received the Spirit of adoption, whereby we cry, Abba, Father.

Rom 8:16 The Spirit itself beareth witness with our spirit, that we are the children of God:

Rom 8:17 And if children, then heirs; **heirs of God, and joint-heirs with Christ**;

2. Victory over Death.

Adam was created to live forever but, if he sinned even once, he would die. In our redemption in Jesus, we have a better covenant.

Rom 8:1 [There is] therefore now no condemnation to them which are in Christ Jesus, who walk not after the flesh, but after the Spirit.

Rom 8:2 For the law of the Spirit of life in Christ Jesus hath made me free from the law of sin and death.

Heb 2:14 Forasmuch then as the children are partakers of flesh and blood, he also himself likewise took part of the same; that through death <u>he might</u> destroy him that had the power of death, that is, the devil;

Heb 2:15 And deliver them who through fear of death were all their lifetime subject to bondage.

2Ti 1:10 But is now made manifest by the appearing of our Saviour Jesus Christ, who hath abolished death, and hath brought life and immortality to light through the gospel:

3. Partaking of His Divine Nature.

2Pe 1:3 According as his divine power hath given unto us all things that [pertain] unto life and godliness, through the knowledge of him that hath called us to glory and virtue:

2Pe 1:4 Whereby are given unto us exceeding great and precious promises: that <u>by these ye might be partakers of the divine nature</u>, having escaped the corruption that is in the world through lust.

Col 2:9 For in him (*Christ*) dwelleth all the fulness of the Godhead bodily. Col 2:10 And <u>ye are complete in him</u>, which is the head of all principality and power:

Eph 3:17 That Christ may dwell in your hearts by faith; that ye, being rooted and grounded in love,

Eph 3:18 May be able to comprehend with all saints what [is] the breadth, and length, and depth, and height;

Eph 3:19 And to know the love of Christ, which passeth knowledge, that ye might be filled with all the fulness of God.

4. Receiving Glorified Bodies.

1Th 4:15 For this we say unto you by the word of the Lord, that <u>we which</u> <u>are alive [and] remain unto the coming of the Lord</u> shall not prevent them which are asleep.

1Th 4:16 For the Lord himself shall descend from heaven with a shout, with the voice of the archangel, and with the trump of God: and the dead in Christ shall rise first:

1Th 4:17 Then <u>we which are alive [and] remain</u> shall be caught up together with them in the clouds, to meet the Lord in the air: and so shall we ever be with the Lord.

1Co 15:50 Now this I say, brethren, that flesh and blood cannot inherit the kingdom of God; neither doth corruption inherit incorruption.

1Co 15:51 Behold, I shew you a mystery; **We shall not all sleep** (*die*), but we shall all be changed,

1Co 15:52 In a moment, in the twinkling of an eye, at the last trump: for the trumpet shall sound, and the dead shall be raised incorruptible, and we shall be changed.

1Co 15:53 For this corruptible must put on incorruption, and this mortal [must] put on immortality.

1Co 15:54 So when this corruptible shall have put on incorruption, and this mortal shall have put on immortality, then shall be brought to pass the saying that is written, <u>Death is swallowed up in victory.</u>
