

A. Mark 11:22.

1. Different Translations.

NIV: **“Have faith in God,”** Jesus answered.

Amplified: Jesus replied, “Have faith in God [**constantly**].

Berean Literal, Literal Standard:

And Jesus answering, says to them, "Have faith **from** God.

Aramaic Bible in Plain English:

Yeshua answered and he said to them, **“May the faith of God be in you.”**

2. More Literal Translations.

Godbey NT: And Jesus responding says to them, **Have God's faith.**

Geneva 1587, Worrell, Young's Literal Translation:

And Iesus answered, and said unto them, **Have the faith of God.**

Smith's Literal Translation:

And Jesus having answered, says to them, Have the faith of God.

Douay-Rheims: And Jesus answering, saith to them: Have the faith of God.

Catholic Public: And in response, Jesus said to them: “Have the faith of God.

B. Have the God-like Faith (Mark 11:22).

1. You have the faith of God.

Gal 2:20 I am crucified with Christ: nevertheless I live; yet not I, but Christ liveth in me: and the life which I now live in the flesh **I live by the faith of the Son of God**, who loved me, and gave himself for me.

Ps 82:6 I have said, Ye are gods; and all of you are children of the most High.
v7 But ye shall die like men, and fall like one of the princes.

John 10:34 Jesus answered them, Is it not written in your law, I said, Ye are gods? v35 If he called them gods, unto whom the word of God came, and the scripture cannot be broken; v36 Say ye of him, whom the Father hath sanctified, and sent into the world, Thou blasphemest; because I said, I am the Son of God?

2. We are like Jesus.

1 John 3:2 Beloved, now are we the sons of God, and it doth not yet appear what we shall be: but we know that, when he shall appear, we shall be like him; for we shall see him as he is.

Rom 8:29 For whom he did foreknow, he also did predestinate to be conformed to the image of his Son, that he might be the firstborn among many brethren.

John 14:12 Verily, verily, I say unto you, He that believeth on me, the works that I do shall he do also; and greater works than these shall he do; because I go unto my Father.

C. Every Word You Speak Comes to Pass (Mark 11:23).

1. Mark 11:23 (KJV) For verily I say unto you, That whosoever shall say unto this mountain, Be thou removed, and be thou cast into the sea; and shall not doubt in his heart, but shall believe that those things which he saith shall come to pass; he shall have whatsoever he saith.

Mark 11:23(ABC) For verily I say unto you, That whosoever shall say [**as an individual occurrence (G2036)**] unto this mountain, Be thou removed, and be thou cast into the sea; and shall not doubt in his heart, but shall believe that those things which he saith [**as an ongoing lifestyle (G3004)**] shall come to pass; he shall have whatsoever he saith [**as an individual occurrence (G2036)**].

2. Deut 30:19 I call heaven and earth to record this day against you, that I have set before you life and death, blessing and cursing: therefore choose life, that both thou and thy seed may live:

Pro 18:21 Death and life are in the power of the tongue: and they that love it shall eat the fruit thereof.

D. Agree with Jesus (Mark 11:24).

1. Mark 11:24 Therefore I say unto you, What things soever ye desire, when ye pray, believe that ye receive them, and ye shall have them.
2. Matt 18:19 Again I say unto you, That if two of you shall agree on earth as touching any thing that they shall ask, it shall be done for them of my Father which is in heaven.
