

The Hope of Glory

Overview: The flow of the power of God in our lives is from the inside to the outside. As we continue to live in Christ Jesus, we mature more into walking in the fulness of Christ. As we understand more of the power of Christ in us, we become more of an unhindered conduit for the power of God to flow through us to change our world, and our circumstances, and the lives of those around us. We pass on nothing but the glory.

A. Old Testament – Tabernacled among Men

1. The Tabernacle in the Wilderness. Ex 20:18-20; Ex 40:34-38
2. Solomon’s Temple. 1 Ki 8:27-28; 2 Ch 5:12-14

B. New Testament – Tabernacled in Man

1. The Holy Spirit, which is in you, is the Spirit of Truth. Joh 14:17, 26; 16:13-15
 - a. He will teach you all things.
 - b. Bring to remembrance all that Jesus has said.
 - c. Guides you into all truth.
 - d. Speaks what He hears from God
 - e. He will show you things to come.
 - f. He will show all that is yours through joint heirship (Rom 8:17) with Jesus.
 - g. He will glorify Jesus.
2. You are the temple of God, the Spirit dwells in you. 1 Cor 3:16
3. The anointing in you teaches you all things. 1 John 2:27

C. Christ in You

1. Christ in you, the hope of glory. Col 1:27-28
 - a. The anointed one and His anointing.
 - b. Hope – a confident expectation.
 - c. Manifested glory – the presence of God affecting others.
 - d. The outworking of glory is our perfection. (Heb 10:14)
2. When Christ is in you, you are complete. Col 2:9-10
 - a. All the fulness of the Godhead in Christ.
 - b. All the fulness of Christ in us.
 - c. Result is completeness in Christ.
3. Jesus and His prayer for the church. John 17:21-23
 - a. God in Jesus, Jesus in us, that we may be one.
 - b. The glory in us, that we may be one.
 - c. Jesus in us, the Father in Jesus, that we may be perfect in one.
4. Filled with all the fulness of God. Eph 3:16-19
 - a. Strengthened with might by the Spirit in the inner man that:
 - Christ may dwell in your hearts by faith.
 - You may be rooted and grounded in the immeasurable love of Christ.
 - You might be filled with all the fulness of God.
5. Rivers of living water flowing out of you. John 7:37-39
