

Review:

1. We are all living in the Age of Grace; but coming under grace is a personal choice, the choice to accept Jesus, to obey God or obey satan.
2. Rom 14:23 for whatsoever is not of faith is sin.
1 John 1:9 If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just to forgive us our sins, and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.
3. If you are in the Glorious Church, it means that you remain under Grace at all times, so that you commit no sin and your iniquities do not impact you.
4. We approximate being a part of the Glorious Church by choosing to abstain from sin, to confess known sins & to deal with the unknown sins.

Unknown Sins Prayer (USP) Updates:

1. The primary benefit of USPs is that they keep you focused on God.
2. USPs move you under grace but then God does what you say (Mk 11:23).
3. Rapid Fire (RF) USPs totaling 100 -1200 per day have often produced spontaneous miracles within the first 2 weeks; but not thereafter.
4. Daily Goals: IU 50, RF 100, IS (Intermittent Sets depend on the sets).

A. Overview.

1. God says what He means and means what He says.
Matt 24:35 Heaven and earth shall pass away, but my words shall not pass away.
2. Rev 21:7 He that overcomes shall inherit all things; and I will be his God, and he shall be my son.
1 John 5:5 Who is he that overcomes the world, but he that believeth that Jesus is the Son of God?
3. Rom 8:14 For as many as are led by the Spirit of God, they are the sons of God. **In ABC terms, this is Interval Living at all times.**
4. Eph 5:25 Christ also loved the church, and gave himself for it;
v26 That he might sanctify and cleanse it with the washing of water by the word, 27 That he might present it to himself a glorious church, not having spot, or wrinkle, or any such thing; but that it should be holy and without blemish.

B. Many are called, few are chosen.

1. Ahaz 2 Chronicles 28:
v1 Ahaz was twenty years old when he began to reign, and he reigned sixteen years in Jerusalem: but he did **not** that which was right in the sight of the Lord, like David his father:
v2 For he walked in the ways of the kings of Israel, and made also molten images for Baalim. V3 he burnt his children in the fire.

2. Israel and Judah.

2 Ch 28:5 Wherefore the Lord his God delivered him (*Ahaz*) into the hand of the king of Syria; And he was also delivered into the hand of the king of Israel, who smote him with a great slaughter v10 And ye purpose to keep the children of Judah and Jerusalem for bondmen and women.

3. Believers and Unbelievers.

Jn 8:31 Then said Jesus to those Jews which believed on him, If ye continue in my word, then are ye my disciples (*students*) indeed;

Jn 8:32 And ye shall know the truth, and the truth shall make you free.

Matt 4:19 And he saith, Follow me, and I will make you fishers of men.

4. Elect and Very Elect.

Matt 24:24 For there shall arise false Christs, and false prophets, and shall shew great signs and wonders; insomuch that, if it were possible, they shall deceive the **very** elect. *It is up to you to recognize deceptions.*

C. Live as the New Creation.

1. 2 Cor 5:17 Therefore if any man be in Christ, he is a new creature: old things are passed away; behold, all things are become new.

2. New creation has a new language: Christianese.

Your mind is the battleground but it is for control of your tongue.

Protect your Mind of Christ to protect your heart.

Protect your heart to protect your words.

Protect your words to protect your life and health (Pro 18:21).

3. Your Words are the Key.

God cannot go against your words because He gave you a free will.

The devil cannot go against your words because he has been defeated.

Every challenge you are battling is because the devil deceived you to say (or do) what the devil wants you to say (or do), most commonly due to offense and unforgiveness and pride. Affirm: TSD (Think, Say, Do).

4. Habits.

a. To be willing to change our habits, we must have in our hearts the reality of John 10:10.

b. Development of a habit.

Thoughts produce words, words produce actions, actions produce behavior, behavior produces habits, habits produce character, character determines your destiny. How many habits are preteen?

c. Practice doing God things to replace good things.

Develop God habits (Matt 5 - 7) to replace devil habits.

d. Rapid Fire USPs to remain under grace by overcoming hindrances:

Offense and unforgiveness.

Ongoing unknown sins (e.g., lack of love; pride; impatience; fear; etc.).

Lack of growth in the Word of God.
