

Foundation Scriptures

1 John 3:2 Beloved, now are we the sons of God, and it doth not yet appear what we shall be: but we know that, when he shall appear, we shall be like him; for we shall see him as he is.

3 And every man that hath this hope in him **purifieth himself**, even as he is pure.

Overview

Rom 8:29 For whom he did foreknow, he also did predestinate to be conformed to the image of his Son, that he might be the firstborn among many brethren.

Eph 5:27 That he might present it to himself a glorious church, not having spot, or wrinkle, or any such thing; but that it should be holy and without blemish.

Rom 8:30 Moreover whom he did predestinate, them he also called: and whom he called, them he also justified: and whom he justified, them he also glorified.

Matt 7:24 Therefore whosoever heareth these sayings of mine, and doeth them, I will liken him unto a wise man, which built his house upon a rock:

A. Lay your foundation.

Be proactive. Don't wait for challenges.

Start building your Ark of Anointing.

1. Protect your heart and mind.

1 Cor 2:16 In the Name of Jesus, I have the mind of Christ.

Ps 19:14 In the Name of Jesus, God gives me the words of my mouth and the meditations of my heart.

Pro 4:23 Keep thy heart with all diligence; for out of it are the issues of life.

2. Fill your heart with God.

In the Name of Jesus, my heart is full of Christ, love and the engrafted Word.

God is love. Love never fails.

1 Cor 13:4-8 AmpC Memorize and use it with every interaction with everyone.

B. Build the Framework with the Big Six.

Stay within God's protection. **Stay under grace.**

1. Stay under Grace.

Confess known sins.

Forgive others (check interactions for offense: loss of joy, peace, patience).

Affirmations.

USPs (every 5-30 minutes, do an Unknown Sin Prayer). Target 50 per day.

2. Live a curse-free life (Avoid sins and iniquities).

Tithing.

Attend church services (preferably, at least twice per week).

Note: Periodically, cancel and make null and void every curse spoken by you or against you.

C. Enclose your house with walls by Living the Word.

Live by committing to do the **reason for living**.

Ps 118:17 I shall not die, but live, and **declare the works of the Lord**.

1. Get the Word into your heart to speak and do it.

John 8:31-32 Continue in the Word. Hear and do.

Eph 5:26 Partner with God. Be washed by the water of the Word.

John 10:10 We have an enemy. Satan is trying to kill you.

Matt 7:1-4 Judge not lest you be judged. Consider the beam in your eye.

Forgiving is a gift you give yourself.

2. Avoid Hindrances to the Word.

Hosea 4:6. My people perish for a lack of knowledge.

Pro 10:14 Wise men lay up knowledge: but the mouth of the foolish is near destruction.

Pro 11:30 The fruit of the righteous is a tree of life; and he that winneth souls is wise.

Pro 13:10 AmpC By pride and insolence comes only contention, but with the well-advised is skillful and godly Wisdom.

Knowledge is life but lack of knowledge is destruction.

Luke 6:46 And why call ye me, Lord, Lord, and do not the things which I say?

D. Roof your house with a covering of Life-Saving Habits.

Pro 16:6 By the **fear of the Lord**, men depart from evil.

Be led by the Spirit. Don't be tricked into being BUSY (Being Under Satan's Yoke)

1. Develop Life Saving Habits.

Luke 21:19 In your patience, you will possess your soul.

Pro 8:13 The fear of the Lord is to hate evil: pride, and arrogancy, and the evil way, and the froward (*habitually disobedient*) mouth.

The Word of God works when you work it.

Let God mentor you through your Covenant Matrix.

2. Avoid Death-Producing Habits.

The Big Five: Pride, impatience, fear, unforgiveness, lying.

Fear of Change.

Personality traits.

Complacency.

Lack of motivation.

Laziness (lack of diligence).

Addiction of any types.

Foolish jesting and words.
